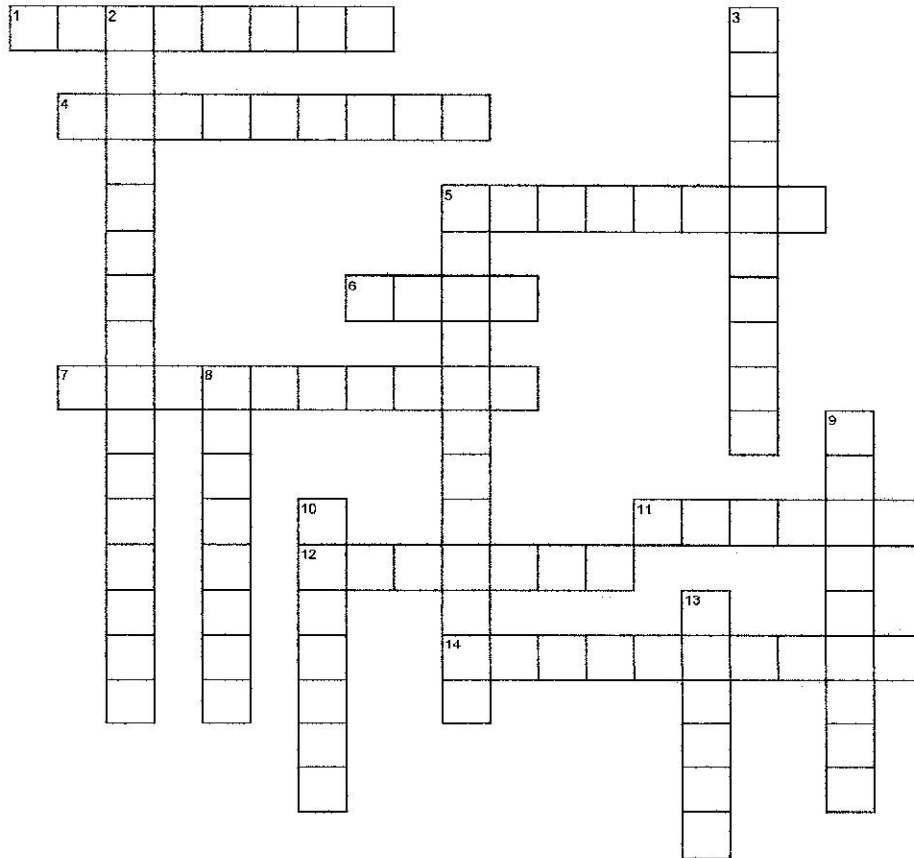


Crossword Puzzle II
